Aggregated Lab Information Grouping Nomenclature (ALIGN)

Overview

The Aggregated Lab Information Grouping Nomenclature (ALIGN) content offering consists of two packages:

- CA - ALIGN Catalogs (Core Catalog)
- CA - ALIGN Reference Maps (Core Reference Map)

An ad hoc publication of ALIGN occurred on February 2, 2023. Updates are scheduled monthly. These content assets are compatible with Symedical 2.3 and later. The next scheduled content release will be early March 2023.

Content Summary

CA - ALIGN Catalogs (Core Catalog)

This package contains two catalogs:

- CA ALIGN
- CA ALIGN Groups

The CA ALIGN catalog serves as the primary mapping target for an ALIGN implementation.

- ALIGN Concepts: 5,413 (Active: 5,412, Retired: 1)
- New ALIGN Concepts: 72
 - Blood Bank: 1 new concept
 - Chemistry: 16 new concepts
 - Hematology/Cell Counts: 6 new concepts
 - Microbiology: 47 new concepts
 - Urinalysis: 2 new concepts

The CA ALIGN Groups catalog has normalized group names and other metadata that are used by the CA ALIGN catalog. There are a total of 2,257 ALIGN Groups. 30 new groups were added, and 0 groups were retired. This catalog is NOT the intended mapping target for an ALIGN implementation. Map to the CA ALIGN catalog instead.

CA - ALIGN Reference Maps (Core Reference Map)

This package contains two reference maps:

- CA LOINC to ALIGN - All
- CA LOINC to ALIGN - Core

Both reference maps contain 5,105 maps from LOINC to ALIGN.
